



## BREAKOUT SESSION: Land as a climate solution: state of play

CLIMATE ACTION, NATURE ACTION, EQUITY ACTION, FOOD & AGRICULTURE PATHWAY

ACTION: Businesses must continue to demonstrate successful examples of land and soil solutions to address the climate crisis, social equity and nature loss.

## **SESSION OVERVIEW**

This session explored the opportunities and challenges that the land sector faces in scaling up solutions to address the climate crisis, social equity, and nature loss. The session was divided into two parts.

The first part covered actions taken within the value chain, where developments in relevant accounting (GHG Protocol Land Sector and Removals Guidance) and target setting (SBTi FLAG) frameworks were presented. Additionally, member companies presented examples of land management solutions to climate change that are also nature and people positive.

The second part focused on taking action beyond the value chain, by explaining the



importance and business case of NCS in doing so, and by providing member case studies that successfully use NCS as a climate, equity, and nature-positive solution.

## **KEY TAKEAWAYS**

- The land sector plays a key role in addressing the climate crisis, social equity and nature loss.
- 1/3 of GHGs come from the land sector, and the latest IPCC reports highlight the importance of increasing solutions of land and soils.
- Business have already been demonstrating successful examples of how to scale up solutions within and beyond the value chain.
- Enabling conditions are also needed to scale up climate-smart practices that have equity and nature co-benefits, such as financial incentives and policies.
